WHY ATTENDANCE MATTERS

There are 194 school days in a given year. Missing a "few" might not seem like a big deal, but "a day here and a day there" can add up to a substantial amount of opportunity lost.

1 day every 2 weeks	20 days per year	4 weeks per year	Nearly 1 ½ years of school
1 day per week	40 days per year	8 weeks per year	Over 2 ½ years of school
2 days per week	80 days per year	16 weeks per year	Over 5 years of school
3 days per week	120 days per year	24 weeks per year	Almost 8 years of school

How about just being late? Surely that won't affect my child's learning?

10 Minutes per day	50 minutes per week	Almost 1 ½ weeks per year	Nearly ½ of a year
20 Minutes per day	1hr and 40 Min per week	Over 2 ½ weeks per year	Nearly one year
30 Minutes per day	Half a day per week	4 weeks per year	Almost 1 ½ years
1 hour per day	1 day per week	8 weeks per year	Over 2 ½ years
